

# 89th ANNUAL NEW YEARS FROSTBITE REGATTA Notice of Race January 1, 2020 & January 4, 2020

## Hosted by the MANHASSET BAY YACHT CLUB Port Washington, New York

Organizing Authority (OA): Manhasset Bay Yacht Club

**RULES:** The regatta will be governed by rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and the following rules. In the event of a conflict between the NOR and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will apply. This changes RRS 63.7.

**SAFETY:** USCG-Approved PFDs shall be worn at all times on the water, except for brief periods when adjusting clothing or equipment. Additional safety rules may be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

**BOW NUMBER RULE:** Bow numbers are required for each InterClub. If two boats have the same "bow/sail" numbers, the boat whose hull's number matches that "bow/sail" number shall display that number. The bow number shall be placed within 1 foot of the bow stem in a color contrasting the hull color. Bow numbers will not be supplied by the OA.

**IDEAL 18:** The same number of crew must sail each race. This changes Ideal 18 Class rule 13.4. All Ideal 18 racing is non-spinnaker.

ENTRY: The Manhasset Bay Yacht Club cordially invites all InterClub, Ideal 18, Lasers and other frostbite one-design class sailors to compete in the New Years Frostbite Regatta. All Past Commodores of the Frostbite Yacht Club are invited to sail in the Past Commodores' Race. Preregistration is encouraged. Entry fee is \$50 for US SAILING members and \$65 for non-US SAILING members, payable to MBYC. Onsite registration will be available from 10:30–11:30 am, Wednesday, January1, 2020.

RACING AREA: The racing area will be Manhasset Bay.

Ideal 18s are reminded to check the tide levels for launching and hauling.

**MEASUREMENT:** It is the responsibility of every competitor to make sure his or her boat, sail, and equipment measure to the current class rules. IC Technical regulations for the InterClub Dinghy Class are Class rules. The skipper and the crew may be required to weigh in before their final registration will be accepted.

**COURSES:** Courses will be windward/leeward or no-jibe type courses.

**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing Instructions will be available during registration/check in hours and will be posted on the MBYC website: <a href="https://www.manhassetbayyc.org">www.manhassetbayyc.org</a>.

**SCORING:** The low point scoring system, RRS Appendix A, will be used, except that no score shall be excluded (no throw out). A DNF will be scored as the number of finishers plus two. This changes RRS A5.

#### PRIZES:

The Baker-Taylor Founders Trophy will be awarded for the highest percentage in any class.

The Sam Wetherill Trophy will be awarded to the outstanding InterClub skipper.

The John P. Barry Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the outstanding Ideal 18 skipper.

The Randy Bartholomew Trophy will be awarded to the outstanding Laser skipper.

The Henry A. Alker Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the outstanding MBYC skipper.

The Geoffrey C. Hazard Frostbite Trophy will be awarded to the outstanding PWYC skipper.

The Robert W. Fraser Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the Past Commodore's Race.

The Anchor Light Trophy for participation will also be awarded.

Appropriate trophies will be awarded in each class.
